

My first days ramble includes the Lands End and the churches of SS. Just, Sennen, Levan and Bwryan. The scenery we met with along the north road, leading from Penzance to St. Just, Churchtown, is a good introduction to the architecture we are to see. Round about is a girdle of sterile moorland, bleak, bare, treeless, relieved only by patches of dark gorse, granite boulders and jutting rocks. As you rise out of one hollow after another the lines of the panorama shift, but the character of the scenery remains. Even the strips of field that presently appear within this ring of savagery do little to humanize a prospect mapped out by walls some eight feet thick, which, while they consume a large slice of the landscape, tell how man in rescuing the soil has had to build or pile up stones ere he began to dig. Presently we are in sight of the Gump and Chun Castle, which lies to the right, and a stone circle and two cairns to the left. One of these cairns bears the ominous name of Cairn Kenidzhek, or the booting cairn. The rocks on its summit take grotesque outlines that harmonize with the general air of desolation. The Gump, Cornish for a plain, is a favourite haunt of the fairies, and...
