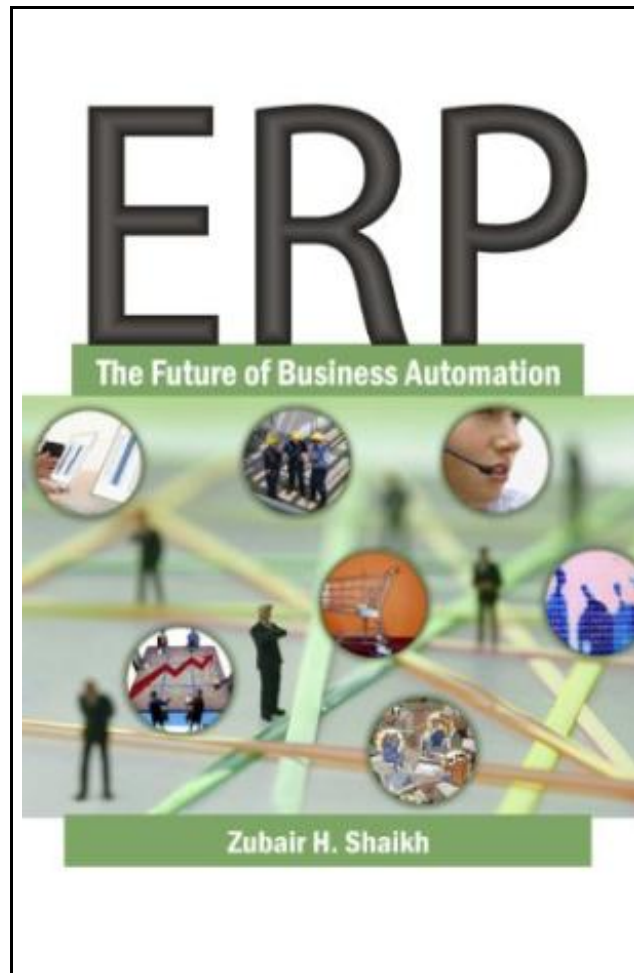

Initially it was called IIS (Information Integrated System).
